Honors IB teachers will test both works the **FIRST** week of school. These works are not fast reads, so students should not leave them until the last minute!

On the back of this paper are instructions for the assignment which accompanies the reading. Students are to make notes for each novel; these will be used to prepare for class discussion, study for the initial tests on the novels, and review prior to the IB English examination in May.

Some copies of the text are available from North's library for summer checkout to registered students. Teachers do recommend that, if at all possible, students purchase both texts, so that they can freely annotate them and use the margins for commentary and reflective questions. This is **NOT** required, however.
